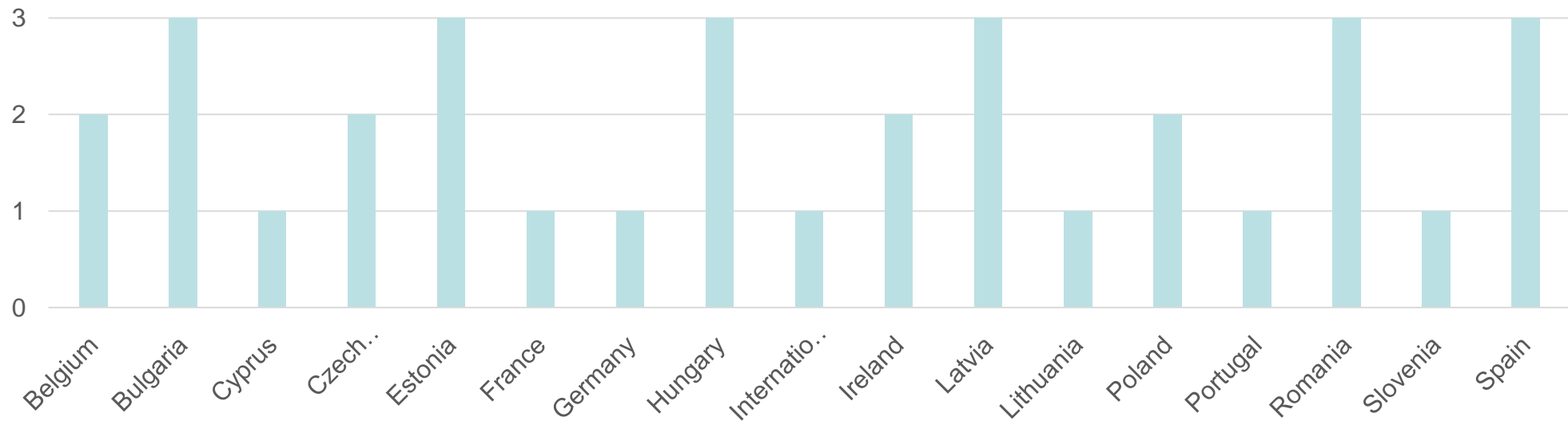

The network counts now with 33 participant NGOs from across 16 European countries

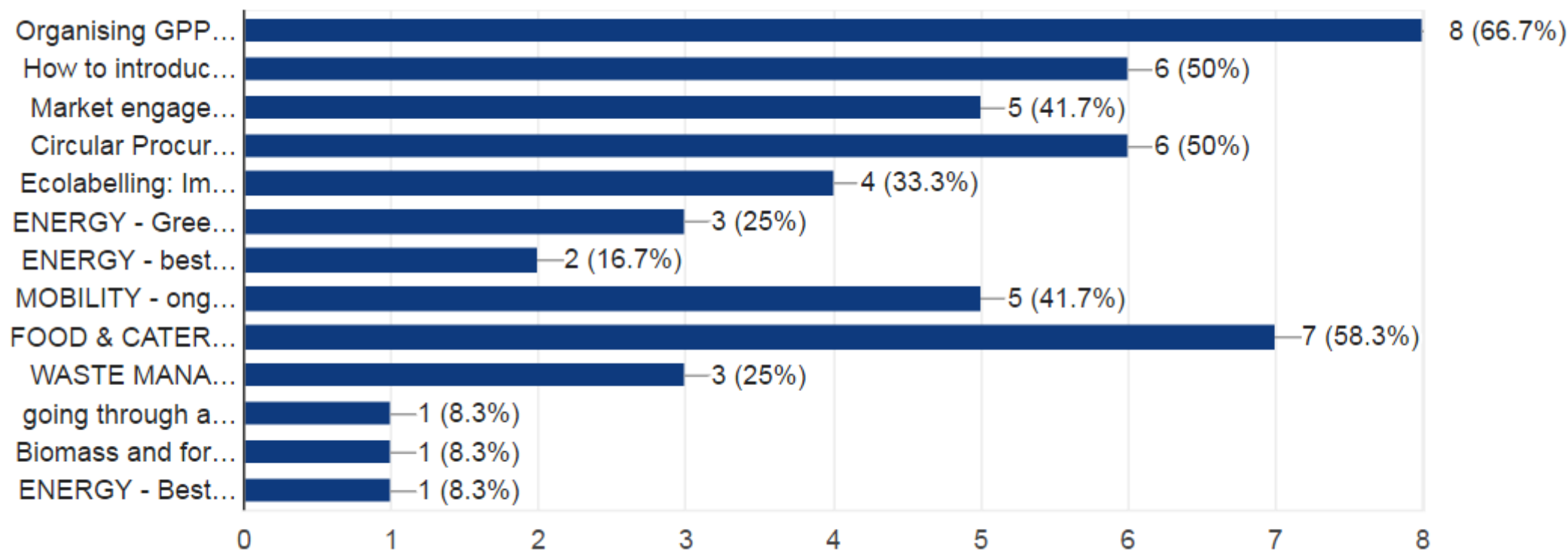

Planned Activities and support from the Network

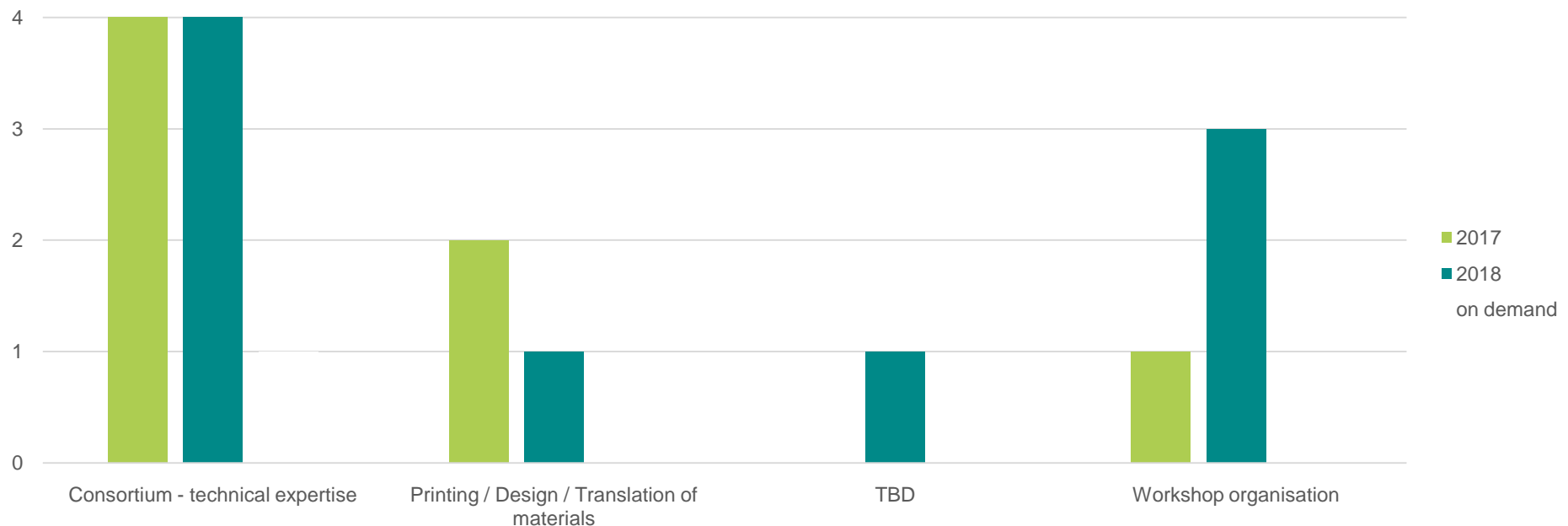


- 1 Capacity building activities - GPP introductory & advanced training sessions
